### HIV Testing Only

Appointments are recommended for those who want HIV testing *only*. HIV testing *only* is free, outside of our walk-in STD Clinics.

Rapid HIV testing is available (mouth swab and 20 minute results).

### Walk-in STD Clinics

**Fridays** 3:30pm - 6:00pm  
and **1st and 3rd Friday** of the month 9:00am—1:00pm

**There is a \$15.00 fee** for each STD Clinic visit. At this time, we do not bill insurance, nor take partial or scheduled payments for this fee.

A Nurse Practitioner offers **examinations** for patients with symptoms, such as: discharge, burning, bumps, itching, odor, etc... **Lab testing** for Gonorrhea, Chlamydia, HIV, Syphilis, and Hepatitis C is available. There is no lab testing for **herpes or genital warts**.

If **herpes or genital warts** is suspected, please visit the clinic when there are visible symptoms.

**Medications** can be provided during the initial clinic visit if the patient has specific symptoms, or if the patient is a sexual partner of someone that has a confirmed STD condition. Paperwork from the original infected patient is required for all **partner treatments**. *All treatments are at the discretion of the Nurse Practitioner.*

**Bacterial Vaginitis, genital warts, herpes, NGU, Trichomoniasis, and yeast infections** are also common. Some treatments are on hand and free during the visit, while some may require a prescription.

\*Patients returning for treatment for an infection diagnosed by this clinic, will be able to return for treatment, with no visit fee, as long as it is within a month of their diagnoses. Genital warts treatment is the only exception.
